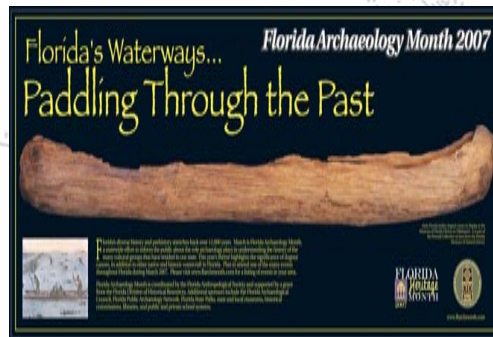
MERITS OF FAC AND WHY WE NEED YOU AND YOUR SUPPORT
